COMMUNICATION WITH ALL COACHES

1. **A CURRENT CELL PHONE NUMBER MUST BE AVAILABLE** for immediate contact with coaches in the event of necessary schedule changes due to weather or other emergencies.

IN CASE IT RAINS

In the event of rain all **COACHES MUST CONTACT THEIR DIVISION COORDINATOR** as listed in the special bulletin headed **IN CASE IT RAINS** (Included in this booklet).

TYPE OF TOURNAMENT

1. There are 9 divisions of teams. There are 146 teams in the tournament.
2. All games will be pool play with bracket winners going to championship and all other teams **PLAYING A FOURTH CONSOLATION GAME DUE TO NEW CIF RULES**. Some divisions will have a wild card team go into the championship.

REPORTING FINAL SCORES OF GAMES

ALL COACHES are to email final scores of their games to **THE UNIONTRIBUNE** at: sports@sduniontribune.com **ASAP** after the games **AND ALSO** text your final scores to Gallagher @ 619-602-8650.

On Wednesday calls of scores must be called in as above AND also be made to their DIVISION COORDINATOR.

UMPIRE ASSIGNMENTS

The San Diego County Baseball Umpires Association and Pacific Umpires will assign two umpires to each game.

CRITERIA FOR BREAKING TIES OCCURRING AT THE END OF "POOL" PLAY

1. Head-to-head competition.
2. Least amount of runs allowed.
3. Greatest number of runs scored up to seven (7) runs
4. Greatest number of "shut-out" innings. (Innings remaining in a game ending before seven (7)innings have been played because of tournament ground rules or Federated rules, will be counted as "shut-out" innings through seven (7).
5. Coin flip. (By tournament manager: by phone, if necessary).

GAME INFORMATION

1. All games will be seven (7) innings except as noted in No. 2 below. National Federation rules will be in effect except as noted in this Information Bulletin.
2. THERE IS NO TIME LIMIT TO GAMES. (EXCEPT FOR MERCY RULE BELOW)
3. If a team is ahead by ten (10) runs, five (5) innings have been completed and two (2) hours have elapsed, the game shall be called by the umpire. Otherwise, **no time limit is placed on any game.**

GROUND RULES

1. HOME TEAM will be determined by a coin flip in ALL games.
2. Infield practice will be limited to ten (10) minutes per team. Visiting teams will take infield practice last.
3. Teams are to be at their playing field at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the starting times.

BASEBALLS

Each team must provide two (2) new baseballs for each game through the semifinals. BASEBALLS FOR THE FINALS WILL BE FURNISHED.

PITCHING LIMITATION RULES

The Lions Tourney will follow CIF San Diego Section Pitching Rules

PITCHING LIMITATIONS

ARTICLE 150 BASEBALL

1500. Pitching Limitation Rules – 30 OUTS

Sections shall adopt the following baseball pitching limitation rule: 30 outs and/or three (3) appearances in a calendar week through the season.

- A. The calendar week begins on Monday.
- B. Innings pitched in a no game (i.e., rainout, power failure, etc.) shall count toward the total.
- C. If the 30th out involves a double or triple play, the team will not be penalized.
- D. An appearance is defined as a pitcher pitching at least one (1) pitch. If a pitcher is removed from the mound to another position or to the dugout and later returns to pitch in the same game, the pitcher will be charged with a second appearance.
- E. Any violation constitutes a forfeit of the contest.

1501. PITCHING LIMITATION RULE – PITCH COUNT

In addition to 1500 above, Sections shall adopt the following baseball pitching limitation rule with respect to pitch count and required days of rest:

Pitch count limits and required rest:

Level	Maximum Contest Pitch Limit	0 Days Rest Required	1 Day Rest Required	2 Days Rest Required	3 Days Rest Required
Varsity	110 Pitches	1-30 Pitches	31-50 Pitches	51-75 Pitches	76+ Pitches
Freshman; F/S; JV	90 Pitches	1-30 Pitches	31-50 Pitches	51-75 Pitches	76+ Pitches

- A. A pitcher may finish the current batter if the Maximum Contest Pitch Limit is reached during that at-bat.
- B. Pitches thrown and appearances made in a no game (i.e., rainout, power failure, etc.) shall count toward the totals.
- C. At the end of each half inning, the head coaches will confirm and both team books will record the pitch count for all pitchers who threw a pitch in that half inning. In the case of a discrepancy, the home book is considered the official book.
- D. Each school must keep a record of all pitches thrown by each of their players in each game and make this available to their respective Section Office upon request. E. Any violation constitutes a forfeit of the contest.

Questions & Answers:

Q: If a pitch count mechanism is used that is visible to both teams, do the coaches still need to confirm the pitch count every half inning? A: No. If the mechanism (i.e. scoreboard add-on, flip chart behind home plate, etc.) can be seen by both teams, the coaches may use that as verification of the pitch count.

Q: How is a day of rest defined?

A: A day of rest is defined as a calendar day. For example, if a pitcher throws 76 or more pitches in a Monday game thus requiring threedays rest before being allowed to pitch again, those days of rest would be Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday allowing that pitcher to pitch again on Friday.

Q: If a pitcher exceeds the maximum number of allowable pitches with respect to the required days of rest while finishing a batter, how are the required number of rest days calculated?

A: The required days of rest is determined by the actual number of pitches thrown. For example, if a pitcher starts a batter with 48 pitches, finishes the batter with 53 pitches and is then removed from the game, that pitcher would be required to rest for two days before making another appearance.

Q: What, if any role, do the umpires play in the confirmation and recording of the pitch count after each half inning?

A: The umpires are asked to ensure that the teams are exchanging the required information but the actual recording of the pitch count is up to the head coach from each school.

Q: If an intentional walk is issued to the batter and no pitches are delivered to home plate, are those pitches counted towards the pitcher's total number?

A: No. Those pitches would not count towards the pitcher's total number

Q: In the case of balk, when does a pitch count towards the pitcher's total number? A: A pitch would only count if the ball is delivered to the batter.

Q: If a batter is awarded timeout by the umpire but the pitcher still delivers the ball to the batter, does that pitch count towards the pitcher's total number?

A: No. That pitch would not count towards the pitcher's total number.

Q: Does the Pitch Count reset each Monday like the 30 Out Rule?

A: No. While the 30 Out Rule will reset each Monday, the Pitch Count Rule will not. For example, if a pitcher throws 76+ pitches in a game on Saturday, they would have to rest on Sunday, Monday and Tuesday before being eligible to pitch again on Wednesday.

Q: May the same pitcher appear in two different games on the same day?

A: Yes. However, they may only do so if they threw 30 pitches or less in the first game and are not required to rest. Also, they may not throw more than 110 pitches total for the day.

RULES COMMITTEE

Final decisions on disputes not coming under the jurisdiction of the baseball rules and umpires' decisions will be referred to the tournament director and to the tournament rules committee. Decisions will be final.

DIVISION COORDINATION

Each division is assigned a Lions Club member as **DIVISION COORDINATOR** to help with scheduling and rescheduling of games, places and times. **Division Coordinators will be the contact point for scheduling the Thursday games.**

Scores need to be called or preferably texted daily to 619-602-8650 and also called in to the Division Coordinator on Wednesday only. If it rains, it doesn't necessarily mean your game will be rained out or will have to be rescheduled. **Contact with your coordinator will be necessary to learn what to do.**

Your **DIVISION COORDINATOR** will contact you prior to the tournament.

IN CASE IT RAINS

Each division is assigned a Lions Club member as **DIVISION COORDINATOR** to help with scheduling and rescheduling of games, places and times. A Coach Assistant from each division has been designated to assist the **DIVISION COORDINATOR** as necessary. If it rains, it doesn't necessarily mean your game will be rained out or will have to be rescheduled. **Contact with your coordinator will be necessary to learn what to do.** Your **DIVISION COORDINATOR** will contact you prior to the tournament.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO IF IT RAINS

Coaches should work with their Lions Club **DIVISION COORDINATORS**. Call your **DIVISION COORDINATOR** about the status of your game for that day. Your **DIVISION COORDINATOR** will inform you about any required schedule change. Contact your **DIVISION COORDINATOR** for the game time of the next days' games. **HOST FIELD COACHES** need to call the **DIVISION COORDINATOR**, if fields are not playable so umpires can be informed of canceled games.

HOST FIELD COACHES can purchase four bags of quick-dry before contacting your **DIVISION COORDINATOR** for authorization to purchase more.
